The LPN prepares patient for provider office visits which includes medication reconciliation, reviewing preventative services due, vital signs, immunization administration, all patient forms for office visit and collecting pertinent health information.

Manage nurse visit calendar and post visit cares which include medication administration, immunizations, blood pressure checks, suture/staple removal, dressing/wound care, ear washes, specimen collections and other nursing procedures.

Work collaboratively with registered nurses and providers to relay test results, assist with prescription discrepancies, and other health follow up via telephone, prior authorizations, and online services.

The licensed practical nurse (LPN) provides nursing care to assigned patients under the direct supervision of the registered nurse (RN) and accepts delegation from the RN/assigned supervisor in meeting the needs of the patient/family.

The LPN possesses excellent communication skills; is skillful in mentoring and instructing; and may participate on committees or projects, including quality improvement projects
